24	YEDC budget reflects only one minimal
25	contractural increase. Previously we

3	bear bones. So, only necessary
4	operational expenses are reflected
5	here. So, that has not changed other
6	than one small increase in our annual
7	audit fee.
8	MS. SINGER: Do you have any
9	questions?
10	MR. KISCHAK: I have no
11	questions.
12	MS. SINGER: May I have a
13	motion to accept the budget and the
14	three year budget plan?
15	MS. KIMBALL: I'll make a
16	motion.
17	MR. KISCHAK: I'll second it.
18	MS. SINGER: The resolution for
19	consideration is the authorizing
20	resolution on the mortgage recording
21	tax for Extell Hudson Waterfront.
22	MR. ROTHMAN: Yes. Good
23	morning. So, the Extell development
24	team applied and submitted an
25	application to the IDA last year. As

2	part of that process their
3	application was also referred to the
4	EDC.
5	The company is looking to
6	develop approximately 1,395
7	residential rental units, about 1,587
8	parking spaces and just over 48,000
9	square feet of commercial space.
10	The company went through the
11	IDA process. The IDA induced, had a
12	public hearing and has authorized
13	participation in its normal quote
14	unquote straight lease transaction.
15	As part of their application
16	they were expecting a full board for
17	recording tax exemption. That would
18	be through the Economic Development
19	Corporation.
20	So, the resolution before you
21	would authorize the EDC to provide
22	that exemption, and that exemption
23	only, and if there are any questions,
24	I'd be happy to answer them.
25	MC CINCEP: The IDA is not by

2	law allowed to provide this
3	exemption. And so, it is our
4	understanding and counsel's advice
5	that it is within the purview of the
6	Yonkers Economic Development
7	Corporation to provide this tax
8	exemption.
9	So, on that bases are, there
10	any questions?
11	MR. KISCHAK: No, I'm fine.
12	MS. KIMBALL: I'm fine. I will
13	make a motion.
14	MR. KISCHAK: And I will second
15	it.
16	MS. SINGER: Are there any
17	legal updates?
18	MS. GROSZ: Not at this time.
19	MS. SINGER: Is there any other
20	business?
21	MS. KIMBALL: I just want to
22	point out, Cecile, that our last
23	meeting was Greg Young's last meeting
24	with the city and he passed on. I
2.5	wanted to acknowledge his service
