Budget and the three year budget plan are before you.

MS. MCGILL: The 2019 proposed YEDC budget reflects only one minimal contractural increase. Previously we

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had scaled down on this budget to the bear bones. So, only necessary operational expenses are reflected here. So, that has not changed other than one small increase in our annual audit fee.

MS. SINGER: Do you have any questions?

MR. KISCHAK: I have no questions.

MS. SINGER: May I have a motion to accept the budget and the three year budget plan?

MS. KIMBALL: I'll make a motion.

MR. KISCHAK: I'll second it.
MS. SINGER: The resolution for consideration is the authorizing resolution on the mortgage recording tax for Extell Hudson Waterfront.

MR. ROTHMAN: Yes. Good
morning. So, the Extell development team applied and submitted an application to the IDA last year. As

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part of that process their application was also referred to the EDC.

The company is looking to develop approximately 1,395 residential rental units, about 1,587 parking spaces and just over 48,000 square feet of commercial space.

The company went through the IDA process. The IDA induced, had a public hearing and has authorized participation in its normal quote unquote straight lease transaction.

As part of their application they were expecting a full board for recording tax exemption. That would be through the Economic Development Corporation.

So, the resolution before you would authorize the EDC to provide that exemption, and that exemption only, and if there are any questions, I'd be happy to answer them.

MS. SINGER: The IDA is not by

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law allowed to provide this exemption. And so, it is our understanding and counsel's advice that it is within the purview of the Yonkers Economic Development Corporation to provide this tax exemption.

So, on that bases are, there any questions?

MR. KISCHAK: No, I'm fine.
MS. KIMBALL: I'm fine. I will make a motion.

MR. KISCHAK: And I will second it.

MS. SINGER: Are there any
legal updates?
MS. GROSZ: Not at this time.
MS. SINGER: Is there any other business?

MS. KIMBALL: I just want to point out, Cecile, that our last meeting was Greg Young's last meeting with the city and he passed on. I wanted to acknowledge his service.

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MS. SINGER: Yes. Greg Young
was here for a considerable length of time. He had a distinguished background of service both in the New York State Assembly and here in Yonkers, and we wanted also to remember him and his passing and his service to the city.

So, we would like to adjourn in his memory.
