2	MAYOR SPANO: Roll call.
3	MS. LYRAS: Mayor Spano.
4	MAYOR SPANO: Here.
5	MS. LYRAS: Cecile Singer.
6	MS. SINGER: Here.
7	MS. LYRAS: Wilson Kimball.
8	MS. KIMBALL: Here.
9	MS. LYRAS: Roberto Espiritu.
10	MR. ESPIRITU: Here.
11	MS. LYRAS: Pete Kischak and
12	Melissa Nacerino are excused.
13	MAYOR SPANO: We have a quorum.
14	We have the minutes for the March
15	25th meeting. I am assuming
16	everybody was here, so Wilson made a
17	motion that we except the minutes,
18	seconded by Cecile. All in favor?
19	(A chorus of ayes.)
20	MAYOR SPANO: Any negatives?
21	It is passed. Mary, number three.
22	MS. LYRAS: In the month of
23	March we received two million in
24	agency fees closing on QIC Ridge
25	Hill. Our cash on hand as of March

2	31st is 2.3 million dollars, and we
3	have our accountant, Peter Diehl, on
4	hand if anyone has any questions.
5	MAYOR SPANO: Any questions?
6	MS. SINGER: Motion.
7	MAYOR SPANO: Cecile made a
8	motion, seconded by Wilson. All in
9	favor?
10	(A chorus of ayes.)
11	MAYOR SPANO: Any negatives?
12	The item is passed. Jaimie.
13	MS. MCGILL: First resolution
14	for consideration is Authorizing
15	resolution approving financial
16	assistance to Dayspring Commons,
17	L.P., also known as WestHab Inc. In
18	the form of mortgage recording tax
19	exemption.
20	MAYOR SPANO: Okay. Any
21	questions.
22	MR. CURTI: Just for the
23	record, the mortgage recording tax
24	exemption would apply to a mortgage
25	in the approximate amount of

2	\$40,605,000 translating into a
3	mortgage recording tax relief of
4	\$730 , 890.
5	MS. SINGER: Motion.
6	MS. KIMBALL: Second.
7	MAYOR SPANO: Seconded by
8	Wilson. All in favor?
9	(A chorus of ayes.)
10	MAYOR SPANO: Item is passed.
11	We all know WestHab is another one of
12	our people that puts forth workforce
13	housing so that individuals
14	especially are able to participate in
15	all the wonderful things that are
16	happening in our Yonkers community,
17	especially South Yonkers.
18	There will be a couple of
19	hundred units on Elm Street and the
20	city has been very helpful and a
21	partner in terms of the property and
22	with these benefits so, you know, it
23	is a good use of taxpayer money, so
24	item two.
25	MS. MCGILL: Final resolution

2	approving financial assistance to
3	78-80 Morningside LLC in the form of
4	mortgage recording tax exemption.
5	MR. CURTI: For the record, The
6	amount of mortgage that would lien
7	the property would be \$1,380,000 and
8	that would translate into a mortgage
9	recording tax exemption of
10	approximately \$24,840.
11	MAYOR SPANO: Motion from
12	Wilson, seconded from Cecile. All ir
13	favor?
14	(A chorus of ayes.)
15	MAYOR SPANO: Any negatives?
16	The item is passed.
17	MS. MCGILL: Resolution to
18	approve the distribution of funds for
19	Yonkers Historical Society for repair
20	of the Sherwood House. We have
21	Judith Waite and Mark Silberblatt
22	from the Yonkers Historical Society
23	here.
24	MAYOR SPANO: Okay.
25	MS. KIMBALL: I believe this

2	came up because you had a
3	conversation with the head of the
4	Historical Society, Mayor, on some
5	important
6	MAYOR SPANO: Yes. We had a
7	conversation about a wall that was
8	caving in on the building that we
9	know that's a historical landmark
10	here in the City of Yonkers, the old
11	farmhouse.
12	MS. SINGER: Sherwood House.
13	MAYOR SPANO: I know that they
14	could have gone to New York State to
15	apply for some dormitory grant
16	funding. I think the damage is such
17	that it is happening and it is real
18	and needs to be repaired and needs to
19	be repaired now, so we have the
20	ability to be helpful here and save a
21	historical landmark that is in our
22	city, so my recommendation is that we
23	pass this.
24	MS. KIMBALL: Anything you want
25	to add

2	MR. SILBERBLATT: Thank you,
3	Mayor Spano, thank you to all the
4	members.
5	In addition to the wall issue
6	that was described, there are and
7	we have set it out in a memo that we
8	presented to Ms. Kimball which I am
9	sure you are aware, there are a
10	number of items that urgently need
11	addressing.
12	There are three structures, one
13	of which is basically goes back to
14	1740 and that's the Sherwood House
15	itself which is a museum.
16	There are two associated
17	structures, one is a barn and the
18	other is a cottage. They both go
19	back to mid 19th century, and as we
20	have outlined, there are a number of
21	pressing items that require
22	restoration.
23	We have gotten estimates for
24	the work that would be required. We
25	sent them out in our memo and that's

2	what we are asking your help with.
3	MS. SINGER: We certainly
4	treasure anything in the City of
5	Yonkers. The problem is so many
6	parkways that come in around it that
7	it's isolated from the public, so I
8	hope going forward you will do more
9	things to involve the public so
10	people understand it's in the City of
11	Yonkers, but what Sherwood has is a
12	very important part and one that
13	should be appreciated by more people,
14	so I congratulate you for working so
15	hard to make all of us aware of what
16	is needed and certainly look forward
17	to the day that it will be completed.
18	MS. KIMBALL: Motion.
19	MAYOR SPANO: Thank you. I
20	just echo the words of Cecile. Thank
21	you. You work so hard and you keep
22	that facility alive and vibrant and
23	very much available to our families
24	here in Yonkers, so I think we can be
25	helpful here but don't forget our

2	state partners.
3	MS. WAITE: We have an
4	application into the New York State
5	Preservation League.
6	MAYOR SPANO: Good.
7	MS. WAITE: To cover the cost
8	of the architectural engineer who is
9	advising us, so after meeting with
10	them on Friday we hope everything
11	will go well, and we have also, as
12	you know, applied we have this
13	ongoing grant since way back.
14	Finally, the last piece has
15	gone to the state to make the
16	building accessible to people in
17	wheelchairs and who have trouble
18	walking, so I turned the last piece
19	in this week, and in 2015 we had the
20	big dinner that raised \$20,000 to
21	match the CBDE grant that would match
22	the state grant so we are finally
23	getting all that done.
24	MAYOR SPANO: Cecile seconded
25	the motion All in favor?

3	MAYOR SPANO: Any negatives?
4	Hearing none, the item is passed.
5	MS. WAITE: Thank you.
6	MS. MCGILL: The next item is
7	authorizing resolution approving
8	financial assistance to CPG Phase III
9	Limited Partnership in the form of
10	mortgage recording tax exemption.
11	David Rothman from Harris Beach.
12	MR. ROTHMAN: Very briefly,
13	this project goes back to 2017.
14	There was a closing with the Yonkers
15	IDA, the Yonkers YEDC, City of
16	Yonkers, State of New York and
17	various other partners, is a
18	construction of 70 mixed income
19	units.
20	As part of the budget there
21	were certain environmental
22	remediation work that was being
23	undertaken. That is about 6.3
24	million. That was based on borings
25	and site analysis.

2	It turns out the extent of the
3	remediation work was greater than
4	forecasted, so the company, actually
5	yesterday, advised that the total
6	increase was approximately 2.2
7	million.
8	They have asked that this body
9	provide the mortgage recording
10	exemption for that 2.2 million, which
11	equates to \$39,600 in additional
12	exemption. That resolution is before
13	you.
14	That would be the only
15	additional benefit that they would be
16	provided.
17	MAYOR SPANO: Any questions?
18	MS. KIMBALL: No. I make a
19	motion.
20	MAYOR SPANO: Wilson made a
21	motion, seconded by Cecile. All in
22	favor?
23	(A chorus of ayes.)
24	MAYOR SPANO: Any negatives?
25	The item is passed.

2	MR. CURTI: There is one legal
3	update. Just to apprise the Board,
4	many of you know the facility that
5	was formerly known as Leakes and Watts
6	has recently changed its name to
7	Rising Ground now.
8	As you may recall, the YEDC did
9	issue some bonds some years ago for
10	the benefit of Leake and Watts to do
11	some improvements on their site.
12	Because of the change in the name we
13	had to notify the bond holders, so
14	the Executive Director signed a
15	consent about a couple of weeks ago,
16	so we just want to advise the Board,
17	this is really a ministerial item but
18	we wanted the Board to know.
19	MAYOR SPANO: Okay. Any other
20	business? None.
21	MS. KIMBALL: Motion to
22	adjourn.
23	MAYOR SPANO: Wilson made a
24	motion to adjourn, seconded by
25	Cecile. All in favor?
