MR. KISCHAK: Here.
MS. LYRAS: Melissa Nacerino.
MS. NACERINO: Here.
MS. LYRAS: We have a quorum.
MS. SINGER: The minutes of the YEDC's last meeting are before you. And if you can just take a look at that.

MR. KISCHAK: I make a motion to accept.

MS. NACERINO: Second.
MS. SINGER: Thank you. Any
objections?
The motion is carried, the minutes are accepted.

Review discussion of the

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engagement letter.
MR. DANIELE: I believe the engagement letter is in your packet.

Again, $I$ don't anticipate any change in scope of the service other than the fact that the unwind of the new market tax credit that happened last year, which we won't hopefully see this year. So the fee we kept flat compared to last year. So no increase.

MR. KISCHAK: That's good news.
MS. SINGER: And can you tell
us about what was the fee last year?
MS. MCGILL: There's no
increase. 17,500.
MS. SINGER: Do you have any questions about the fee?

MR. KISCHAK: No.
MS. NACERINO: No.
MS. SINGER: May I have a motion to accept.

MR. KISCHAK: I make a motion.
MS. NACERINO: Second.

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MS. SINGER: We have accepted the engagement letter for the EDC. Now the review and discussion of the order plan.

We have just gone through what you're pro forma. Can you point out what would be different for the EDC from the IDA?

MR. DANIELE: Sure. So the process is the same. As I mentioned, last year there were some notes and loans receivable that were forgiven. So those are off the books. You do have some agency fees that you collect, and there are some professional fees that you spend.

Other than that, we shouldn't see any of the new market tax credit transactions affecting the corporation for 2019. I'm not sure of the activity yet until we get in here for 2019.

MS. SINGER: Do you know
anything about the amount that we

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expect from the new market tax credit?

MS. MCGILL: That was all
wrapped up.
MS. LYRAS: It was all last year.

MS. MCGILL: So it shouldn't be a part of this year.

MR. DANIELE: Correct.
MS. MCGILL: So there's nothing to look at.

MR. DANIELE: Actually, the IDA assumed the loan from the YEDC. So the only thing outstanding is a note for about $\$ 2.6$ million on the IDA's books.

MS. LYRAS: Correct.
MR. DANIELE: Which would be received if -- I believe if the Larkin garage is profitable. So we'll have to look at that piece of it too when we do the audit.

MS. SINGER: Do you have any questions about it?

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MR. KISCHAK: No.
MS. SINGER: So we'll again say
all the time factors are the same.
MR. DANIELE: Yes. As part of our preliminary audit for the IDA, we're also going to look at the YEDC. So we do those hand in hand. And when we came back in February, we'll --

MS. SINGER: So you know from the point of view, the people who are on this board, that the YEDC is a more sensitive place and requires additional attention.

MR. DANIELE: Yes.
MS. SINGER: And we depend upon
the fact that you will advise us about what is going on and whether there are any problems in the State of New York that may come back to us in this area.

MR. DANIELE: Okay.
MS. SINGER: Because that's
always a concern because of the way

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it's structured.
MR. DANIELE: Structured. Yes.
I think a lot of it was cleaned up last year. So now you have your normal agency type transactions. The loans were forgiven, off the books. So --

MS. SINGER: Are there any questions?

MS. NACERINO: No.
MR. KISCHAK: No.
MS. SINGER: If there are no further questions, then I will ask for a motion to adjourn the meeting.

MR. KISCHAK: I make a motion.
MS. NACERINO: Second.
MS. SINGER: So the meeting now stands adjourned. And we thank you for your assistance and look forward to a very comprehensive but very good audit.

MR. DANIELE: Thank you.
