management. Once you accept these we can go final with them, with the exception of some public authorities' documents that we'll get today or tomorrow.

Same approach to the IDA. The EDC is a little less in scope as far as audit work, but same audit approach: We kind of get an understanding of any changes, any information flow, then we look at the agency fees that are generated based on contracts that are closed on in the fiscal year.

So if we turn to the financial highlights, we're going to turn to page 3 again, comparing the activities for 2021, you can see the YEDC generated agency fees of almost \$1.1 million, compared to \$350,000 last year.

You did close on some large projects: Lionsgate, \$700,000 was generated; Ridge Hill, another

2 \$327,000. Those are some bigger items.

Your expenses, most are in line. Consulting fees are down, actually, compared to 2021. The EDC was paying some consulting fees for the repair on the garage -- and that occurred through August -- and those costs are now absorbed by the City of Yonkers. You have your professional fees, you can see that's up. And that's mostly your outside attorneys, Harris Beach, mostly onthe Cacace garage. And that's what caused the increase in the current here.

The other expenses are in line with the exception of community relations. You can see that's up \$1.2 million. The Economic Development Corporation did spend \$750,000 for funding for a War Memorial, as well as, I believe, Ray Park. So that was some big costs in the current year that were all

So you had operating revenues of \$1.1 million; you had operating expenses of \$1.5 million. So the EDC generated a loss, if you will, in the current year, to the tune of about \$422,000. You subtract that from your opening net position of \$3.2 million and end the year at \$2.8 million.

If we turn back to page 2, you can see that mostly, the \$2.8 million is all in the form of cash. And again, to Jim's point, this is also in Signature Bank, but obviously, the new bank has taken over and these deposits are fully collateralized, as well as with the \$250,000 FDIC, as well as collateral that's required in New York State for theres cash and CDs and things like that.

So again, you did spend some money down based on these activities, but you still have \$2.8 million as of

We also have to report the schedule of cash and investments to the public authorities. Again, no different than what's reported here, the \$2.8 million. And we also have a report to those charging governments to you folks. And again, I'm happy to report that there were no findings to report to the Yonkers Economic Development Corporation as of 12/31/2022.

Again, the back schedule, it's pretty much the same as the IDA. We issued an opinion, it's a clean opinion, it's the highest level of opinion that we can offer to an entity.

And again, really, there aren't many estimates here. It's mostly money that's spent during the year.

You don't have receivables; you don't have payables. There's really no estimates to make. Your balance
